



World of Wrestling presents. . . 23rd Annual RENO WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS



DATE: April 3 -5, 2020

SITE: Reno Livestock Events Center, 1350 North Wells Avenue, Reno, Nevada. Just blocks away from exciting downtown Reno.

RULES: Modified National Federation High School Rules (minimum rest between matches and maximum number of matches in a day not in effect). Out of bounds will be modified college rules (one body part in bounds, cylinder.) Hair code, skin check & fingernails will be enforced by referees. Skin conditions, if required, must be on a National Federation medical release form (found at www.worldofwrestling-roller.com) and dated within 10 days of event. Hair cover (if required) must be with wrestler at weigh-in. Must make weight in competition singlet. Head gear is optional, however highly recommended!

ENTRY DEADLINE: Must be received by March 23, 2020. Must make weight entered. No changes at weigh-in.

FEES: Pre-entry of \$50.00 to be paid by March 23, 2020. Wrestler may enter only one weight class and only one age group. No moving after entry deadline. Please pay and enter as a team when possible. No refunds!

FORMAT: Folkstyle. Double Elimination. Challenge for second format. Referee decisions final.

PROTEST FEES: (1) Age Protest fee is \$40, and must be directed to tournament directors. All age protests must be made before final match of protested wrestler's first session of wrestling. Birth certificates must be available on the first day of wrestling for all wrestlers in case of a protest. (2) The video challenge fee is \$100.00 and must be presented at the mat table at the time of the challenge. Only the FLO camera will be utilized for the review. Video challenges are only allowed during semi-finals and all placement matches. The video challenge **MUST BE MADE IN A TIMELY** manner. If the challenge is upheld or video is inconclusive the fee will be returned. If the challenge is lost or the video is inconclusive, contestants will no longer be able to challenge for the remainder of the tournament.

AWARDS: Medals 1st through 6th for 6, 8, 10, and 12 & under. Medals 1st through 8th for 15 and 18 & under. Show the world you are a true All American! Outstanding Wrestler Trophy in each age group based on champion with most falls in least amount of time (including technical falls). Special awards for top 3 placers per weight category. Each age group will have a Team Champion and a runner-up based on point criteria 14-10-7-4-2-1-1/2-1/4; if tied, second criteria will be highest placement. Also overall Team Champion for all divisions. Teams to be considered for team competition must register with exact team name. We will not change these for you. **Must be present to win.** These awards are unparalleled in our sport - you must see to believe.
