

FORMAT: Collegiate style. Double Elimination. Challenge for second format. Referee decisions final.

PROTEST FEES: (1)Age Protest fee is \$40, and must be directed to tournament directors. All age protests must be made before final match of protested wrestler's first session of wrestling. Birth certificates must be available on the first day of wrestling for all wrestlers in case of a protest. (2)Video challenge fee is \$100, and must be presented at the table to a director before the review. Only the official Flo camera at the table will be used. If the call is overturned then \$100 refund will be given. Only reviewable video challenges will be during semi-finals (on both sides of the bracket) & all placement matches.

TIME PERIODS: OPEN & GIRLS: 6 and 8 & Under 1-1-1 all matches including finals. 10, 12, and 15 & Under  $1^{1/2}$  -  $1^{1/2}$  -  $1^{1/2}$  including finals. Consolation Matches 1-1-1. Overtime — NFHS rules. See website for Rules & Guidelines.

AWARDS: Medals 1st through 6th. Special Awards for 1st through 3rd. Outstanding Wrestler Trophy in EACH age group based on champion with most falls (including technical falls) in least amount of time. Team Trophy in each age group. Team with most points based on point system 14-10-7-4-2-1 is champion. If tied, next criteria is most champions. Must wrestle for your own team. Teams to be considered for team competition must register with exact team name. We will not change these for you, so it's best to register everyone together. Must be present to win. Second leg of Trinity Award and a qualifier for World All Star Team.

CONDUCT: A wrestler may be disqualified for misconduct on or off the mat during the tournament.

### HISTORY –

In 1955 Tulsa, the hotbed of Oklahoma high school wrestling, had only one organized wrestling team below the high school level. That one team was an independent operating outside of the school system as does all junior wrestling in Tulsa. In order to build a strong junior program, a group of concerned individuals started an open tournament in 1956. At the first tournament, elementary and junior high wrestlers participated in the same division. The following year the tournament was divided into elementary and junior high divisions and was called the Junior Olympics. Now the format is 6, 8, 10, 12, and 15 year olds and under.

The NATIONALS has grown from its infancy of 1955 to one of the largest and most prestigious junior tournaments in the country. Each year it attracts approximately 2000 young wrestlers from throughout the United States. This year, the tournament will be conducted on 11 mats. We will have the grandest of opening and closing ceremonies. Former Tulsa NATIONALS champions have gone on to become outstanding wrestlers in national and international competition. It is the goal of the NATIONALS not to provide the largest tournament, but one with outstanding competition and the best possible conditions for young wrestlers to compete. The challenge to each of you is to participate in a tournament which is so rich in tradition and to encourage you to strive to be the best you can be. "DARE TO ACCEPT THE CHALLENGE"!

### **WOW Tournament Rules & Guidelines**



- Modified National Federation High School rules. Out of bounds will be modified college rules (a single body part of either contestant, within the wrestling cylinder.) Safety will be the main concern.
- 2. Minimum rest between matches and maximum number of matches not in effect. Exception: If requested, 6 and under through 18 and under will have a 10 minute rest period between matches.
- 3. Birth Certificates must be available if requested by a tournament director.
- 4. (1)Age Protest fee is \$40, and must be directed to tournament directors. All age protests must be made before final match of protested wrestler's first session of wrestling. Birth certificates must be available on the first day of wrestling for all wrestlers in case of a protest. (2)The video challenge fee is \$100.00 and must be presented at the mat table at the time of the challenge. Only the FLO camera will be utilized for the review. Video challenges are only allowed during semi-finals and all placement matches. The video challenge MUST BE MADE IN A TIMELY manner. If the challenge is upheld or video is inconclusive the fee will be returned. If the challenge is lost or the video is inconclusive, contestants will no longer be able to challenge for the remainder of the tournament.
- 5. Head gear is optional however, highly recommended!
- 6. Hair cover is NOT required.
- 7. Child abuse, abusive language, disorderly conduct, etc., will not be tolerated and will be dealt with severely.
- 8. No cameras on floor of any kind unless approved by WOW.
- 9. Press or Media Passes must be pre-approved prior to entry deadline.

- 10. Coaches Passes and/or Floor Passes must be visible.
- 11. Must register under the exact same team name to compete for team awards and to receive Coaches Passes.
- 12. Total number of Coaches Passes determined by number of entries: 1 Coaches Pass for every 5 wrestlers registered together as a team. Example: 25 wrestlers = 5 free Coaches Passes. Free passes must be picked up during weigh-in! No Exceptions!
- 13. Must Pre-Pay & Pre-Enter NO LATE ENTRIES. Must enter online.
- 14. Time Periods are as follows: 6-8 and under: 1-1-1 10-12-15 and under: 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> 18 and under: 2-2-2 All Consolation Matches: 1-1-1
- 15. Round Robin Ties 1st criteria most wins, 2nd criteria head to head, 3rd criteria most falls (including Technical Falls). Any exhibition match does not count toward any awards.
- 16. Outstanding Wrestler Award Based on a champion with most falls in least amount of time (including Technical Falls).
- 17. Must be present to win any Awards.
- 18. We reserve the right to make changes to the schedule as necessary. If any changes are made they will be posted at weigh-in and on social media.
- 19. A Trinity Award will be presented for any wrestler that wins Kickoff, Tulsa Nationals, and Reno Worlds. You do not have to wrestle the same weight at all 3 events, but must be in the same division. This is also offered for the Girls! We have the option to combine weights.

### — WORLD OF WRESTLING DIRECTORS —

Shane Roller – Executive Director. Shane wrestled in his first Tulsa Nationals at the age of 5, and he won 8 consecutive Tulsa Nationals titles throughout his elementary career. He won 12 state championships including 4 high school state titles. He wrestled in college for Oklahoma State University, where he was a 3x All-American. Shane is married to Jennifer, and they have 2 boys and 2 girls. He has been helping with World of Wrestling events for over a decade.

Tom Holland – Director of Officials. Currently serving as Director of Officials for World of Wrestling. Coached Youth and Jr. High wrestling programs for eight (8) years. Officiating experience includes: Over three decades of High School officiating which includes numerous Oklahoma team Duals and season tournaments, post season qualifying and State Championship tournaments. Numerous Beast of The East tournaments, Reno Tournament of Champions tournaments, NWCA tournaments, AAU Folkstyle tournaments, AAU Disney Duel tournaments and AAU Folkstyle Official of the year recognition. As Director of Officials the duties include mat set-up and markings, hiring officials, supervising weigh-in procedures, mat and floor crowd control, safety issues and Head Officials responsibilities at World of Wrestling events. Tom also received the Lifetime Service Award and entered into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame.

Steve Dalton – Director of Tournament Operations. He has been involved in wrestling since the 1990s. He has been an OKWA wrestling official for many years. He is essential in the overall operations of World of Wrestling. Steve's duties include pre-event coordinator, post-event coordinator, tournament operations, floor control, organization of mats and tables.

Brandon Wright – Director of floor. Brandon has been a part of the WOW family for over 10 years. He's married to Rebecca, and a loving father of 3; Jaxen, Randen & Brooklyn. His current role is floor director and his duties include mat set up, and floor security. He has been involved in the sport of wrestling for years whether coahcing or supporting and cheering on the kids. 


**Danny Hodge** 

Over 35 years ago, "The Legend" of wrestling began presenting the awards at the Tulsa Nationals and has continued being the star ever since. A real hero for America's youth. He is the sport's great ambassador. He was a three time NCAA champion; a 46-0 collegiate record; 24 consecutive pins; never taken down; a Golden Gloves boxing champ; chairman of the Oklahoma wrestling and boxing commission; junior heavyweight professional boxing champ; and charter member of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame.



**Shane Roller** 

Attended his first Tulsa Nationals at the age of five and proceeded to shatter the existing records. He currently holds the record with eight Tulsa Nationals championships. He has coached teams, presented awards, conducted clinics and still makes time for his fans. He won twelve state championships including four high school state titles; the 1998 Wrestling USA's top wrestler of the nation; first recipient of the Junior Hodge Award; Asic's All America first team member; and a three time NCAA All American while wrestling at Oklahoma State placing third two times and fourth once.



**Kenny Monday** 

The recipient of five Tulsa Nationals Championships and a loyal supporter ever since. He has been involved in the ceremonies and coached teams for years. He has duplicated his success in producing many national champs. His achievements were herculean. He was Oklahoma's first four time undefeated state champion with a record of 140-0-1; a three time Olympian earning the gold in 1988 and silver in 1992; and a three time NCAA All American winning the title in 1984 and runner-up two times. In 1988, he was USA Wrestling's Athlete of the Year. In 1989, he was The Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year.




Jim Keen, Sr.

CEO of Cliff Keen Athletic and striving to make a difference in wrestling by sponsoring a myriad of tournaments including the Wrestling USA/Cliff Keen Dream Team Classic; one of the college premier events, the Cliff Keen National Duals; and plays an active part in the Cliff Keen Tulsa Nationals. He has served on many national committees and has been actively involved with USA Wrestling, the National Wrestling Coaches Association, and the National Wrestling Hall of Fame. He currently serves as Chairman of the Board of Governors of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame. In 2004, Jim received the Order of Merit Award for extraordinary contributions to the sport of wrestling.



**Jack Roller** 

World of Wrestling and Tulsa Nationals executive director. Never wrestled a match but his life has been consumed with wrestling for the past 37 years. He was state director for OKWA for eight years; the tournament director for the Tulsa Nationals for 33 years; in 1995, he was the City of Tulsa's Local Hero; entered into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1995; AAU Wrestling's Man of the Year in 1996; was 2004 Wrestling USA's Master of Wrestling top award recipient; and the 2005 Win Magazine Impact Award winner stating he had the greatest impact on wrestling for the year.



**Tom Holland** 

Began officiating wrestling in 1978. Coached junior high and elementary wrestling programs from 1971 through 1977. He has officiated in many high school tournaments including regionals and state. He has officiated at the Beast of the East, Reno Tournament of Champions, AAU Folkstyle Nationals, and the AAU Disney Duals. He has served as the Director of Officials for World of Wrestling for the past twenty years. His duties include hiring officials, the tournaments' head official, safety codes and mat setup.

**Steve Dalton** 

Steve has been involved in wrestling since the 1990's, and been a director for World of Wrestling since 1992. He has been an OKWA wrestling official for many years. Steve is essential in the overall operations of World of Wrestling. His duties include preevent coordinator, post-event coordinator, tournament operations, floor control organization of mats and tables.

Steve is truly essential in all facets of running this great event. As Director of Tournament Operations, he is the one that is always there for the loading and unloading and all that's in between of each World of Wrestling event. A true friend to all of wrestling and absolutely deserving of such a great honor.



John Smith

Nobody has put together a more celebrated wrestling career that John Smith. Smith won six world championships from 1988-92, and is one of the winningest coaches at the most successful wrestling program in the country.


John was a three-time NCAA finalist, winning two titles. Following Smith's junior year at Oklahoma State, he won his first world championship in Clermont-Ferrand France. Smith remains the only collegiate wrestler to win a world championship while he was still in school.

Following his graduation in 1988, Smith qualified for the U.S. Olympic freestyle team. The Olympics were held in Seoul, South Korea. Smith came away with the gold medal and the second of his six consecutive world titles.

Smith continued to rack up awards and medals after he finished his college career. He was the first wrestler to receive the James E. Sullivan Award given to the nation's top amateur athlete. The U.S. Olympic Committee named him the "Sportsman of the Year" in 1990.

In 1992, Smith was named the Outstanding Wrestler of the Year by FILA, the governing body of amateur wrestling. His wrestling career came to an end later that year after he won his second Olympic gold medal in Barcelona, Spain, and his last of six world championships.

As Head coach, Smith has successfully resuscitated the program back from its darkest hour in the early 90s to the glory that it is experiencing now. Oklahoma State has now won four consecutive national titles, continuing the legacy of Oklahoma State Wrestling. John Smith has said that winning the Tulsa Nationals (formerly the Junior Olympics) twice was certainly the highlight of his young career. He said it was the confidence builder that he needed to succeed in wrestling. He has presented awards and made special guest appearances over the last 12 years. He is a true friend to Tulsa Nationals and certainly deserving of such recognition.





A.L. Haizlip

A.L. has been involved in the sport of wrestling since 1962 as a competitor, wrestling official, coach and public address announcer. His passion for the sport of wrestling and the life lessons the sport teaches young men and women, motivates him to travel from coast to coast, producing wrestling events, opening and closing ceremonies, and music and light shows that make wrestling tournaments spectacular.

He has served as a principal announcer for the National Wrestling Hall of Fame and Museum, and the National Wrestling Coaches Association All Star match. He has also served as media moderator, and has produced musical introductions and entertainment for the NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships.

He served as principal announcer for the 2006 ESPN-U Wrestling Double header. He has served as principal announcer for the National Collegiate Wrestling Association National Championships since 2004.

A.L. has been the voice of Oklahoma University wrestling since 1992, World of Wrestling since 1996, the Big XII Wrestling tournament, Oklahoma City University Wrestling, USA Wrestling National Junior Duals and AAU Wrestling national tournaments. He has served as a member of the Board of Directors of World of Wrestling since 1999. The professionalism he has brought to the Tulsa Nationals for 11 years as an announcer and director has earned him the distinct honor of entering the Tulsa Nationals Hall of Fame.



Paul McCain

In 1972 Paul started his 34 years of service in wrestling with his local Sapulpa Wrestling Club. He has coached for over 27 years and held the position of President with Sapulpa. He is one of the few that can say he attended the first Oklahoma Kids Wrestling Association meeting held in 1979. He was instrumental in forming this great association which many have, and continue to, benefit from each year. Paul joined the Tulsa Nationals team over 20 years ago and has been a Director for the last 16 years. You never see him center stage or out on the mats directing. He was the nuts and bolts behind the scenes of this great event. A great detail organizer whose absence will be missed dearly and he is certainly deserving of this prestigious recognition.

David Alexander

David Alexander wrestled at Tulsa Nationals when it was US Junior Olympics 3 times. David coached at Tulsa Nationals 2 years, 1988 and 89. During his coaching and refereeing years he has seen many of the novice wrestlers he coached placing at Tulsa Nationals and State and go on to wrestle in college. David started wrestling at the age of 12 for the YMCA in Tulsa and continued wrestling through high school at East Central. He became involved in wrestling again when his youngest son, Beau, started wrestling for Tiger Wrestling Club in Broken Arrow. David became an assistant coach for TWC and coached the Novice wrestlers in 1988 and 1989. After 2 years of coaching, David decided it was time to get more involved in another area of wrestling. 

The positive changes that have been made in wrestling concerning better age/weight divisions and weight control measures established in the secondary schools system have all helped to promote the great sport of wrestling.

In regards to Sportsmanship, big strides have been made in youth wrestling regarding the conduct of wrestlers and coaches but there is still work to be done. The NFHS has recognized this and has made Sportsmanship a point of emphasis in the Rules and Case Books.

Our sport is no different than other sports and we routinely see or experience examples of bad sportsmanship from contestants, coaches and parents. With this said it is up to each of us as parents, coaches, contestants and officials to look at what we teach our youth about Sportsmanship AND how we, as adults, exemplify what we teach and expect from our youth.

Sportsmanship not only starts at home but must also be taught and learned from coaches and other important figures in all sports.

Jack Roller – Executive Director. Without ever wrestling a match, Jack's life for the past 40 years has been consumed by wrestling. Beginning as a wrestling parent, he has gone on to become the holder of many positions of authority in Oklahoma wrestling such as regional and state Director of the Oklahoma Kids Wrestling Association. He has successfully directed numerous prestigious national kids wrestling tournaments including the largest and most prestigious kids tournament in the country, the Tulsa Nationals. He has directed many AAU National Championships.

In 1995, he was selected as the recipient of the City of Tulsa's "Local Hero" award for his contributions to the Tulsa community. In 2004 he was chosen by Wrestling USA Magazine for the Master of Wrestling Award as their "Man of the Year". In December of 1995, he received the Lifetime Service Award and entered into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame.

Shane Roller – Executive Director. Shane wrestled in his first Tulsa Nationals at the age of 5, and he won 8 consecutive Tulsa Nationals titles throughout his elementary career. He won 12 state championships including 4 high school state titles. He wrestled in college for Oklahoma State University, where he was a 3x All-American. Shane is married to Jennifer, and they have 2 boys and 2 girls. He has been helping with World of Wrestling events for over a decade.

Tom Holland – Director of Officials. Currently serving as Director of Officials for World of Wrestling. Coached Youth and Jr. High wrestling programs for eight (8) years. Officiating experience includes: Over three decades of High School officiating which includes numerous Oklahoma team Duals and season tournaments, post season qualifying and State Championship tournaments. Numerous Beast of The East tournaments, Reno Tournament of Champions tournaments, NWCA tournaments, AAU Folkstyle tournaments, AAU Disney Duel tournaments and AAU Folkstyle Official of the year recognition. As Director of Officials the duties include mat set-up and markings, hiring officials, supervising weigh-in procedures, mat and floor crowd control, safety issues and Head Officials responsibilities at World of Wrestling events. Tom also received the Lifetime Service Award and entered into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame.

Steve Dalton – Director of Tournament Operations. He has been involved in wrestling since the 1990s. He has been an OKWA wrestling official for many years. I have had several questions about how the All Star Team is chosen. I felt we should let you know the criteria we use. As you see, they are not just picked. They earn this prestigious position by wrestling in the nation's Big Events! We are proud the events are looked upon as the best in the world. That aspect truly makes this All Star Team the top achievement a young wrestler can attain. We take this achievement to even greater heights with awards for each wrestler who wins each weight class.

Be sure to thank the companies that help us make this happen; FLO Wrestling, Nearfall, Wrestling USA and World of Wrestling. These people promote wrestling and your kids.

The following is a schedule of how the points are awarded for the World Series of Wrestling events to determine the 2025 All Star Team. A wrestler will be considered for the weight class he/she placed the most tournaments at . In the event of a tie, a wrestler will be put in the weight in which he/she earned the most points; however, all points will count. WOW will never encourage weight pulling.







I have been closely involved with elementary age thru high school age wrestling for over forty years, as a coach and as a certified official. The positive changes that have been made in wrestling concerning better age/weight divisions and weight control measures established in the secondary schools system have all helped to promote the great sport of wrestling.

In regards to Sportsmanship, big strides have been made in youth wrestling regarding the conduct of wrestlers and coaches but there is still work to be done. The NFHS has recognized this and has made Sportsmanship a point of emphasis in the Rules and Case Books.

Our sport is no different than other sports and we routinely see or experience examples of bad sportsmanship from contestants, coaches and parents. With this said it is up to each of us as parents, coaches, contestants and officials to look at what we teach our youth about Sportsmanship AND how we, as adults, exemplify what we teach and expect from our youth.

Sportsmanship not only starts at home but must also be taught and learned from coaches and other important figures in all sports.
